

## Southern Illinois Zone Championships

### Target Requirements

From Sept 1, 2022, any shooter with less than 500 16-yard targets for the 2023 target year shall shoot no less than Class B. Any shooter with less than 500 handicap targets for the 2023 target year will shoot no closer than 23 yards. Penalty Class B on doubles for any shooter without 300 targets for the current 2023 target year. Shooters that are in the Senior Vet category that declare so at classification will not have penalties.

### **Special Categories:**

1. A Shooter who has not reached his/her 15<sup>th</sup> birthday may declare Sub-Junior.
2. A Shooter who is 15 but has not reached his/her 18<sup>th</sup> birthday may declare as Junior.
3. A shooter who is 65 but not reached his/her 70<sup>th</sup> birthday may declare as Veteran.
4. A shooter who is 70 years of age and older may declare as a Senior Veteran.
5. Shooters who become eligible for a new age-based categories during the target year may elect to continue to compete in the previous category for the remainder of that target year.
6. Junior shooters reaching the age of 18 may continue to declare Junior category for the remainder of the current target year.

### **Information:**

1. All ISTA trophies will be shot off.
2. Cash trophies will be divided.
3. All ties for trophies and zone teams must be shot off before shooter leaves the grounds; otherwise, his/her rights are forfeited for same.
4. Entrant must declare at classification whether he/she resides in or out of zone when entry is made.
5. No withdrawal from an event will be permitted after the first squad has started that event, unless the shoot is suspended by WSRC for reason of weather or other unforeseen conditions.
6. Food will be available onsite for lunch, and dinner.

7. Side by Sides and Golf Carts are allowed by permit only. Please call (618) 295-3263 to get your permit. YOU MUST HAVE A PERMIT. YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO OPERATE WITHOUT PERMIT.
8. Pre-Squad Available on Scoresr.com. Day of Registration will be at the Clubhouse located in Building 310
9. Practice will be West Fields 0, 1 & 2. Program will be shot on 2 trap banks, 8 starting locations using skeet house numbers.
